The S.S. Lapointe Drain, Sulphur Creek, and Muddy Creek feed directly into the western Lake Erie basin and are some of the contributors to the phosphorus and algae problems that plague the western Lake Erie basin. Lake Erie Luna Pier Beach is included in the S.S. Lapointe Drain watershed and was placed on the Section 303 (d) list due to impairment of recreational uses as indicated by the presence of elevated levels of E.coli.

The MDEQ and U.S. EPA approved S.S. Lapointe Drain Watershed Management Plan proposes the implementation of specific best management practices for agriculture, riparian landowners, and urban residents in priority areas of the watershed to address the phosphorus and E.coli issues identified.
