CALL TO ORDER:

The regular meeting of the Erie Township Board was held Tuesday, June 8, 2021, at the Erie Township Hall, 2065 Erie Rd. Erie, Michigan. E. BUSINESS:

1) Bills Approval:

2) MTA Membership Renewal:

3) Health Insurance Renewal:

4) Purchase “Road Closed” Barricades:

Discussion held regarding flooding in Morin Point and non-residents driving down the streets, some traveling too fast which creates waves, and causes damage to personal property including garage doors.

PUBLIC AND BOARD MEMBER COMMENT:

S. Dusseau of Morin Point voiced his concerns with flooding and drain issues. Dan Taylor stated that all drains are clear except where concrete was put. Bill Talbert suggested a crock be placed with a check valve.

S. Dusseau mentioned no wake buoys were missing, P. Zaleski stated that MPFD put the buoys out and people often move them or steal them.

Monroe County Sheriff Troy Goodnough was present and spoke regarding statistics for Erie Township since January 1, 2021.
