# Erie Township – Ordinance No. 120 Monroe County, Michigan Marihuana Business Moratorium Ordinance

An ordinance to protect the public health, safety and general welfare as Erie Township is desirous of providing for an open, informed, and deliberative process to determine whether within the Township of Erie growing and distribution of medical marihuana[marijuana], if any, should occur, and whether other regulatory controls should be implemented, establishing a moratorium on the issuance of any permit or zoning compliance, processing of any permit or zoning compliance application, processing of any rezoning request, processing of any site plan review, special land use request, or any other application for, and on the establishment within the Township of any business for medical marihuana sale or dispensation, marihuana provisioning centers, marihuana safety compliance facilities, or sale of substances that mimic the effects of controlled drugs or substances, and for a grower, processor, provisioning center, safety compliance center, and secure transporter as set forth in HB 4209.

### THE TOWNSHIP OF ERIE, MONROE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

### Section 1: Title

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Erie Township Marihuana Business Moratorium Ordinance.

#### Section 2: Establishment of Moratorium

A six month moratorium or until such time as regulations, ordinances and land use rules are established by Erie Township on the issuance of any permit or zoning compliance, processing of any permit or zoning compliance application, processing of any rezoning request, processing of any site plan review, special land use request, or any other application for, and on the establishment within the Township of any business for medical marihuana sale or dispensation, marihuana provisioning centers, marihuana safety compliance facilities, or sale of substances that mimic the effects of controlled drugs or substances, and for a grower, processor, provisioning center, safety compliance center, and secure transporter as set forth in HB 4209.

### **Section 3: Severability**

The provisions of the within ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, section or part thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall only affect the particular provision, section or part thereof involved in such decision and shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

### **Section 4: Savings Clause**

This Ordinance herein does not abrogate or affect any offense or act committed or done, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any pending fee, assessments, litigation, or prosecution of any right established, occurring prior to the effective date hereof.

## **Section 5: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in Erie Township and shall take effect immediately after the first publication as required by law following adoption by the Township Board.
