

ERIE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 55-A

LIFE INSURANCE

An Ordinance to create and establish a Township life insurance plan for certain classes of Township officers and employees and to authorize the Township Supervisor and the Township Clerk to contract, in the name of the Township, for such plan: to define those classes of officers and employees who shall be covered by such life insurance plan; to set forth the respective per centum shares which Erie Township and the officers and employees shall contribute to the premium or charges arising under such life insurance plan and to further provide for the deduction of contributions from officers and employees compensation; to provide a method for noncoverage of an officer or employee of the life insurance plan; to ratify and confirm the validity of any life insurance plan in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE TOWNSHIP OF ERIE, MONROE COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Erie Township Life Insurance Plan Ordinance.

Section 2

Pursuant to Act #27 of the Public Acts of 1960, as amended, the Township of Erie hereby creates and establishes a life insurance plan for its officers and employees enumerated herein, and for such purposes, also hereby authorizes the Township Supervisor and the Township Clerk to contract, in the name of the Township, subject to approval of the Township Board, with any company authorized to transact such business within the State of Michigan for such life insurance policies.

SECTION 3

The life insurance plan created, established and contracted for under this ordinance shall cover each person within the following classes of officers and employees:

All members of the Township Board

All Township employees who are employed for not less than thirty-seven and one-half (37 1/2) hours per week or are considered permanent part-time.

Although not normally available for voluntary non-permanent part-time employees, firefighters shall be eligible for life insurance as provided to other employees through the Township.

SECTION 4

The Township of Erie shall annually contribute 100 per centum of the portion of the premium or charges arising under such life insurance contract for each person within the class of persons enumerated in Section 3 hereof. Such Township contribution shall be secured from the general fund of the Township. Any person desiring not to be so covered shall give written notice to the Township Clerk that he desires not to be covered or insured and if the notice is received before the person has become insured or covered under the contract, he shall not be covered thereunder. If the notice is received after the individual has become insured or covered, his coverage under the contract shall cease as provided for in the contract.

SECTION 5

The Township of Erie hereby ratifies and confirms the validity of any life insurance plan in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 7

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication and shall be published in the Monroe Evening News, a newspaper of general circulation within the Township of Erie, Monroe County, Michigan within thirty (30) days from date of passage.
