An Ordinance prohibiting the trespass upon public school lands, buildings or premises within Erie Township and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ERIE, COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

- No person shall willfully enter upon the lands, buildings, or premises or any public school within Erie Township without lawful authority, after having been forbidden so to do by the owner, agent, or servant of the owner or the person lawfully in charge thereof.
- 2. No person being upon the lands, buildings or premises of any public school within Erie Township, upon being notified to depart therefrom by the owner, agent, or servant of the owner, or the person lawfully in charge thereof, shall without lawful authority neglect or refuse to depart therefrom.
- 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment in the Monroe County Jail for a period of not to exceed ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township of Erie.
