

TOWNSHIP OF ERIE ELECTION COMMISSION

Resolution to Rearrange Election Precincts in Erie Township

WHEREAS, Section 116-1954-XXVIII, Election Precincts, of the Michigan Election Law, Public Act 116 of 1954, MCL 168.654 to 168.661, provides for township Election Commissions to divide, rearrange or consolidate election precincts; and

WHEREAS, The Township of Erie has determined that rearranging precincts within Erie Township is appropriate for all future elections because of increased absentee voting and the implementation of proposal 2022-2 which enacted mandatory early voting in the state constitution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Erie Township Election Commission hereby directs the Township Clerk to rearrange the existing precincts, which are Precinct 1- Morin Point Fire Station and Precinct 2 – Erie Township Hall, resulting in the following Precinct: Precinct 1 – Erie Township Hall 2065 Erie Rd. Erie, MI 48133, encompassing the entire boundaries of Erie Township, for all elections after November 7, 2023, until further modified, and may it be

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Erie Township Election Commission hereby abolishes the Morin Point Fire Department voting location and creates a single voting location located at the Erie Township Hall, 2065 Erie Rd., Erie, MI. which will now be referenced to as Precinct 1.


